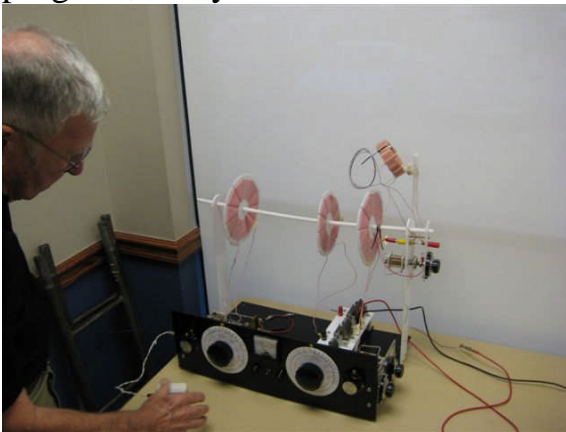


Minutes of Club Meeting
