

ASSOCIATION MONTHLY MEETING MINUTES

DATE: July 18, 2013 LOCATION: Hardesty Library (Tulsa, OK)

The meeting was called to order at 6:30 PM by Gene Vickery, President of the Association. Seventeen members (or visitors) signed the attendance roster.

GENERAL TOPICS

The meeting began with comments about the "Summer Sizzler" event which occurred on June 29 at a new location (Asbury Methodist Church, plus remarks about the Philco 1940's club project.

PROGRAM

This month's program was presented by Curt Lutz and Wayne McGinnis. Curt's topic was "Oscilloscopes". While mostly used in television repair, oscilloscopes can be useful on radios, as well (particularly FM alignment). Curt showed several waveforms at various points in his breadboard radio display. Wayne followed up with comments about the use of scopes in radio repair and handed out several copies of a 1964 Zenith TV receiver.

ITEMS OF INTEREST

Following the program, meeting attendees who brought oscilloscopes (and other items) shared comments on these with the group. These included EICO Model 460 (refurbished by Scott Petty), Heathkit, Tektronics, United Electronics Institute Model 301 (1970's vintage), Clough Brengel (1930's), Hicock Mfg scope developed for the US Navy (1947). An EICO model 364 signal generator was also on the table.

AUCTION

Several items were part of the auction. These included: a thermometer shaped like a cathedral radio and radio-shaped cookie jar.
