



ASSOCIATION MONTHLY MEETING MINUTES

DATE: August 15, 2013

LOCATION: Hardesty Library (Tulsa, OK)

This month's program was an online video of the 500,000 watt WLW radio transmitter facilities in Mason, Ohio. Starting as a 5 watt station in 1921, Hal Crosley consistently increased the wattage, finally working with a team from RCA to achieve the 500kw level. The station operated until 1939 at this wattage strength.

ITEMS OF INTEREST

Following the program, items of interest brought by members included: an early 1920's Precision Instrument tube tester and a 1936 Crosley model 515 "Howling" radio.
