



ASSOCIATION MONTHLY MEETING MINUTES

DATE: October 17, 2013

LOCATION: Hardesty Library (Tulsa, OK)

GENERAL TOPICS

PROGRAM

This month's program was presented by Randy Beeson. His topic was on "Axis Sally" (Mildred Gillars) who participated in a number of radio programs (Home Sweet Home Hour, Midge at the Mike, GI's Letterbox) during World War II designed to demoralize American troops. In 1949, she was found guilty of treason and sentenced to federal prison for up to 30 years. She was released in 1961.

ITEMS OF INTEREST

Following the program, items of interest brought by members included: a 1936 GE All Wave model A125 (5 bands/12 tubes), Mitchell Lullabye Radio, Silvertone radio, and 1934 Montgomery Ward radio.
