DATE: July 17, 2014

GENERAL TOPICS

Gene brought a GE102 superhet to measure voltages and calculate resistance values (series and parallel resistor results).

A 1924 Radiola was brought by Bob Shindhelm. It was the first commercially produced superhet (6 tubes) and cost \$260 in 1924.
