DATE: May 21, 2015 LOCATION: Hardesty Library (Tulsa, OK)

GENERAL TOPICS

The Summer Sizzler is scheduled for June 13 at Asbury Methodist Church.

PROGRAM

This month's program was presented by Scott Petty. The topic was Heinrich Hertz (1857 – 1894), a German physicist who first conclusively proved the existence of electromagnetic waves. Hertz proved the theory by engineering instruments to transmit and receive radio pulses using experimental procedures that ruled out all other known wireless phenomena. The unit of frequency – cycle per second – was named the "hertz" in his honor.

ITEMS OF INTEREST

Items of interest brought to this meeting included: a "tea pot" radio, plus a Zenith battery-style radio, and a ham microphone considered to be the Cadillac of microphones.

AUCTION

Several items were sold at auction. The list included: a military variable frequency oscillator, Weston VOM, and box of tubes (total proceeds of \$32.00).
