

ASSOCIATION MONTHLY MEETING MINUTES

DATE: July 21, 2016 **LOCATION:** Hardesty Library (Tulsa, OK)

The meeting was called to order at 6:30 PM by Randy Beeson, President of the Association. Eighteen members (or visitors) signed the attendance roster.

GENERAL TOPICS

Scott Petty presented a tribute to our long-time (and Charter) member and radio enthusiast, Andy Anderson, who passed away on June 24. The HLARA Sizzler event was held on June 11, 2016. Curt is planning a large auction (tentatively in the fall) located in Collinsville.

PROGRAM

This month's program was presented by Randy Beeson. The topic was the SMS Emden (a German light cruiser) vs HMAS Sydney (an Australian Leander-class cruiser), their history and confrontation during WWI. Randy included comments related to the radio technology used at the time. The Germans used a Telefunken "quenched spark system" which was generally more powerful. Communication was via Morse code.

ITEMS OF INTEREST

Items of interest brought to this meeting included: German EMUD Jr. radio (early 1960's), a 1946 Motorola, a 1948 Zenith "Boom-a-rang" radio and a 1928 QST Magazine.

AUCTION

Several items were sold at auction. The list included radios, parts and books (some donated by Andy Anderson's family), plus various other items. Total proceeds were \$120.00.
